The lady of the lamp

There are many people who have worked all their lives to help others live better and longer lives. Perhaps the best-known of these is Florence Nightingale, who was a nurse and who changed nursing into a respected profession. Before Florence Nightingale began her work, there was no organized nursing in hospitals. She showed how good nursing could impove and often save the lives of sick people. In 1854 Florence Nightingale took a group of English nurses to the Crimea, where Britain and France were at war with Russia. She set up a hospital there and saved from death many people. She became known as 'the lady of the lamp' because she used to go round the hospital at night, helping the patients and the other nurses, and holding an oil lamp in her hand. In 1907 Florence Nightingale was awarded a medal for her work.

Mother Teresa was a nun*. She was born in Macedonia, a country in Central Europe, but she is most famous for her work in India. She lived in Calcutta, one of the poorest cities in India. When she saw childen living in very poor conditions, and sick or unwanted babies left in the streets to die, she decided to do something to help them. When she started, she was working with children who lived on the streets in Calcutta. Soon other nuns wanted to help her with her work. Today these nuns can be seen, dressed in their blue and white Indian saris, working in the poorest areas of cities all over the world. In her lifetime, Mother Teresa received many awards, the biggest of which was the Nobel Peace Prize given to her in 1979. But she always said that her greatest reward was helping people.
